Types of periodical materials covered are feature articles, obituaries, interviews, notices of appointments and awards, regularly appearing columns, special theme issues, editorials (of reference value), letters to the editor (of reference value), and book reviews.

/AB ABSTRACT: When they were young, Caroline Kennedy and her brother John were encouraged by their mother to write or choose favorite poems and illustrate them as gifts. These efforts were assembled in a scrapbook and prompted Kennedy to have a lifelong passion for poetry. In an interview, she discusses such subjects as the role of poetry in her own life and that of her family, the criteria she used to select the poems for the children's collection she edited, the role of poetry in schools, and the part she would like poetry to play in children's lives.
