 intention to sell its Securities Industry Services (SIS) business
 to Westbridge Computer Corporation of Regina, Saskatchewan.

The revenue for IBM's SIS business is in excess of \$25
 million a year. The transaction is expected to be concluded
 in early January 1992, and is subject to regulatory approvals.

"Today's action is another step in IBM Canada's competitive
 restructuring," said Bill Etherington, President and Chief
 Executive Officer, IBM Canada Ltd. "It's part of our overall
 commitment to seek out innovative ways of delivering superior
 business solutions to our customers in a focused, efficient
 manner."

Commenting on the choice of Westbridge as purchaser,
 Etherington said, "IBM Canada has a 27 percent interest in
 Westbridge, which indicates we have a very high confidence in both
 their expertise and potential for success. But more important,
 we believe this action will provide added value to our customers
 by combining IBM's SIS unit with Westbridge's own brokerage
 service offering. Westbridge has a proven history of providing
 a very secure, reliable service, as well as a strong track
 record in helping businesses achieve their strategic goals."

According to J. Gordon Garrett, President and Chief Executive
